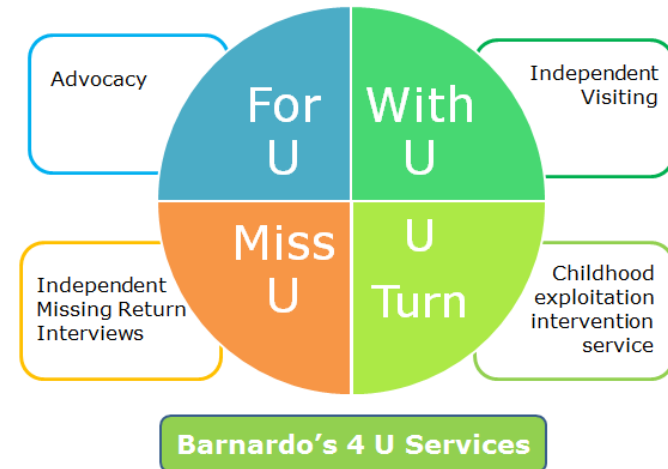

Barnardo's 4 U offers support to children and young people in Portsmouth, Isle of Wight, Hampshire and Southampton

Barnardo's aim to:

Provide quality, independent and confidential services to children and young people.

Barnardo's have been given the National Youth Agency's "HEAR BY RIGHTS" Gold Award. This shows we are passionate about making sure Children and Young People's voices are heard and are at the heart of all services we deliver.

Confidentiality:

Our service is provided on a confidential basis. We will work in partnership with other agencies to ensure children are safeguarded.

Voluntary:

Our service is provided on a voluntary basis and children have the right to withdraw from services. A service will be offered to all children who are referred, or who self-refer and meet service criteria.

U-Turn: Offering information and support to children and young people up to the age of 18 who are at risk of, or are experiencing, Childhood Exploitation of any form. This support is available in all 4LSCB areas.

Miss-U: Offering children and young people an Independent Return Interview after they have been reported missing to Police. This service is available for Portsmouth children and young people who aren't open to social care and Isle of Wight children in off-island care placements.

With-U: An Independent Visitor Volunteer is identified to offer positive activities to children and young people who are in care. This service is available for children looked after by Portsmouth and Isle of Wight Local Authorities.

For-U: A dedicated Advocate will support, empower and, where needed, represent children and young people to get their Views and Wishes heard. This Service is available to children in Portsmouth who are subject to LAC or CP planning and on the Isle of Wight for children who have issues or concerns about their Social Care plans or placements.
