My adults will drop me off at the Belmont Street school gate and pick me up in the playground.

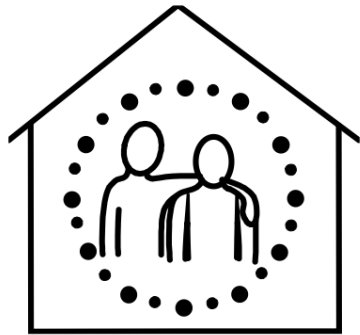


At lunchtime I will eat my lunch with my bubble in the hall. The adults will bring my hot dinner to me.

I can wave to other adults in school too.

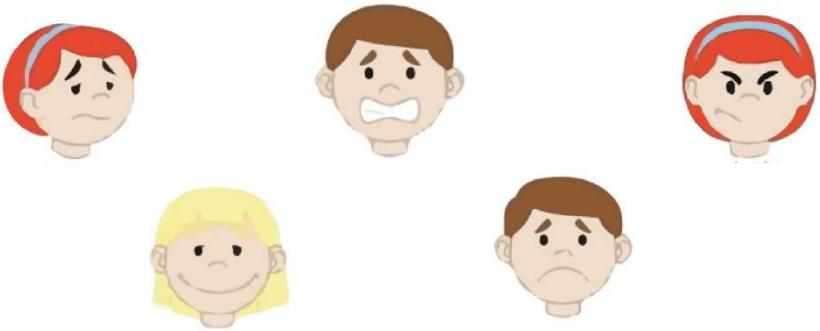


I will need to remember to wash my hands lots and for 20 seconds each time.
