

I go to Cottage Grove Primary




The doctors and scientists

My adults will drop me off at the Belmont Street school gate and pick me up in the playground.




At lunchtime I will eat my lunch with my bubble in the hall. The adults will bring my hot dinner to me.

If I see my friends that are not in my bubble, I can't go and say hello to them, but I can wave!


I can wave to other adults in school too.
