In addition to the Cathedral itself, we also offer the 'Pop-Up Cathedral', a large gazebo printed with windows and artefacts from the Cathedral, which we can take to schools and in which we offer workshops. It can, for example, be popped-up in a playground, either for a day or several days. It is well suited both to educational events, and also to spirituality: we are hoping to use it as a space to help young people process and reflect as we come out of the pandemic.
