Who we are

This work is being carried out by **The Mental Health Delivery Division** which is a part of the Department for Education (DfE). For the purpose of data protection legislation, the DfE is the data controller for the personal data processed as part of the Collection of the list of schools and colleges participating in the Mental Health Support Team (MHST) programme.

How we will use your information

We receive your personal data from the Mental Health Support Teams that work with you in your school or college. The aim for this project is so we can monitor the coverage of the MHST programme and know the number and percentage of schools and colleges that work with MHSTs.

The collection of contact details is to enable us to get in touch with schools and colleges, and specifically to ask them to complete our annual survey of their experiences of working with MHSTs as well as any follow-up from the survey. We may also share this information with the independent evaluators working on behalf of the programme with appropriate data sharing and confidentiality agreements in place.

Who we will make your personal data available to

need to share your personal data with others, we shall ensure that ensure that this data sharing complies with data protection legislation. For the purpose of this project this may include the following:

- Programme delivery partners NHSE, Health Education England and OHID
- Independent evaluators

How long we will keep your personal data

The Department for Education will keep your personal data as part of the Collection of the list of schools and colleges participating in the Mental Health Support Team (MHST) programme for 3 years until the end of the Green Paper programme in March 2025. In March 2025 we will review whether the data needs be retained any longer.
