An experienced, skilled youth team offers a weekly youth group in a safe, secure and supportive environment. There are activities each week designed to help to improve self-esteem, give young people a social outlet in which to make new friends and to provide information to support them as they move into adulthood.

- For **13-18 year-olds**: There is **4U Youth Group**. Tuesdays 6pm 9pm
- For **18-25 year-olds**: There is the **4Me Youth Group**. Thursdays 7pm 9pm.

• For **Under 13s & Parents & Carers**: There is the **4Us Group**. A referral based monthly youth group, plus separate support group for parents/carers. Here primary carers can learn more about LGBTQ topics whilst meeting with other parents/ carers. Alternate Mondays 5pm-7.30pm.
