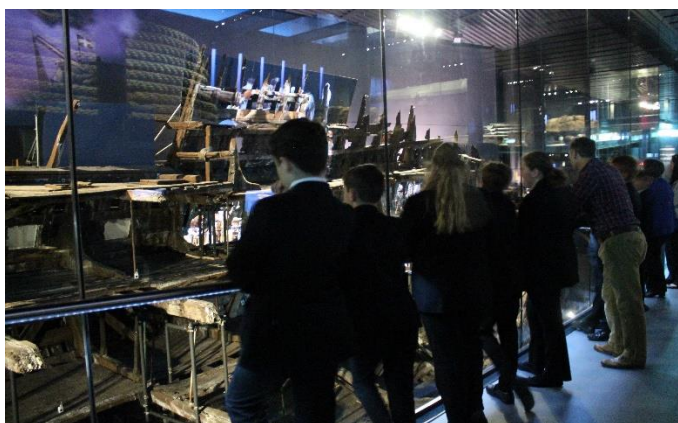
All Aboard Access Fund Round 2.

For visits September – December 2023

The Learning Team at the Mary Rose Museum believe that Learning outside the Classroom has enormous benefits for pupils of all ages and abilities. We are pleased to announce that The Band Trust have kindly funded a second year of this project for 2023. We are looking for local schools who would particularly benefit from this opportunity to enrich curriculum teaching and motivate students in an immersive environment.

Eligible schools will join us for a **free visit to the Mary Rose Museum** plus a workshop, fully funded by The Band Trust. Workshops present a diverse range of evidence, including replica artefacts and scientific information from the skeletons of the crew, to allow pupils to investigate local history in new ways. Themes include teamwork, diversity, rich and poor, materials science and archaeology. All you need to provide is transport – walk, bus, minibus, or train.

Virtual live sessions and outreach boxes are available free of charge for those unable to visit the museum.



If you have time, there is the option this year to add a free self-guided visit to HMS Victory to your booking while it undergoes major conservation works. Please note that Victory is under scaffolding and access is limited to some areas; wheelchair access is only to the lower gundeck. Subject to availability.

What do we need from your school?

Expression of interest from the Headteacher/Lead teacher to include:

- Year group and number of pupils to be considered for the visit
- Available dates to visit between September and December 2023
- Commitment to complete evaluation – pre and post visit
- Permission for photographs (where possible) for reporting purposes and PR
